Freshly back from the Africa Eco Race 2019, the Japanese Kenjiro Shinozuka, winner of the 1997 Dakar Rally with a Mitsubishi Pajero (with the late Henri Magne as a co-driver), and Cathy Derousseaux will participate at Rallye Monte-Carlo Historique by leaving from the Principality.

Loyal to the Japanese brand Mitsubishi, Kenjiro Shinozuka will drive a Colt from 1977.

With a car like that, the team will attempt the impossible.



He also won the Rally Dakar (4 times !), Michel Périn decided to leave aside Rally raid to focus on regularity rally on roads.

JAPANESE STUDENTS ABOUT TO RACE IN RALLYE MONTE-CARLO HISTORIQUE



A team of students from Honda Technical College Japan will participate to the 2019 Rallye Monte-Carlo Historique, for the second time in a row, supported by Axalta Japan (colors expert in Japan)

The team entered with a Subaru 1300G, placed 10th of 184 contestants last year. In 2019, the Honda Technical College students team will participate with a Triumph Spitfire from 1962.

"We're pleased to support the student rally team at the Honda Technical College," said Akira Ueno, Managing Director of Axalta Japan.

Once again, I shall drive my Peugeot 104 ZS2, which I prepare myself with some of my buddies. It's the one and only rally I compete in the whole year, so it's nice to share this moment with my friends who help and follow me on the roads for mechanical service."

TOMORROW'S STARTS



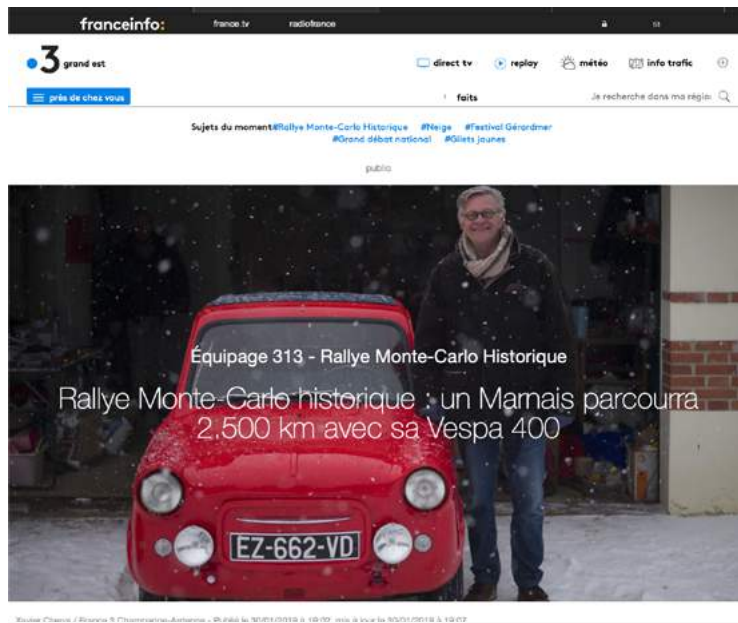
With 5 departures, this Friday will be a busy day!
