



The Danish Roadbook

Safety notes *can be used* when it becomes very difficult to drive because of twisty road (first 3 km on ZR 3) or there is much snow, ice or fog.

It's no longer possible to keep time - it's about limiting losses.

They should be considered as a help and support to know what happens after what you can see from the windscreen

Note	You say	Means
R	Right	Right
L	Left	Left
1	1	Over Square / Acute / Narrow
2	2	Square
3	3	Mid (Challenging corner)
4	4	Fast (Relatively easy corner)
5	5	Flat out (Almost straight forward)
60	60	Meters straight to next note
60~	60 twist	see thru twisty turns to next note
/	Over	Over
-	Then	Natural driving flow from one corner to next
=	Into	short distance - fast directional shift
ℓ	Long	Long bend
ℓℓ	Long, long	Very Long bend
ℓℓℓ	Long, long, long	Very Long bend Continues Long
Hairpin L	Hairpin Left	Hairpin Left
Hairpin R	Hairpin Right	Hairpin Right
<	Opens	Opens up and gets easier
>	Closes	Closes - get tighter - turn more
Road X	Junction	Junction
Bridge	Bridge	Bridge (Over, Into, From, Under)
Below	Below	Below
Top	Crest	Crest
Top down	Crest Down	Continues down hill after the crest
Top +	Crest full	Full speed over crest
Slippery	Caution Slippery	Caution Slippery tarmac
